



3. Click on Register New Software and enter the activation code from your book.




4. Download the software installer and follow the onscreen instructions.

#### 1. Plan your story

Visit huehd.com/tutorials to learn everything you need to know about setting up and using your animation software.




#### 4. Select your camera

Open **Camera Settings** and select your HUE HD camera.



#### 5. Take a picture

Click the **Capture** button, then move the object and take another picture.



Your software will have options to add music and sound effects to help bring any movie to life. The downloadable Activity Pack contains sample sound effects to get you started.

# fun things to try





Set the frequency of frames taken and the duration of your movie.

#### **Disappearing act**

Make something disappear by removing a small part closest to the ground each time you take a picture.



# Filming from above

Place your background flat on the table and mount the camera above it.

You can also turn the camera upside down and flip/mirror the image in the **Camera** menu.



### saving and sharing

You can save your project at any time by choosing **Save** from the **File** menu. Many apps also include an **autosave** feature.



When your movie is finished, select **Export** or **Share** from the **File** menu to create a movie file.

You can then share your movie on your preferred video streaming platform.
